

Let us be gentle with ourselves and others, and as we say on Sundays, let care be the watchword of our lives together.

Not only by the staff here at The Community Church, but by the congregation and community as a whole. I come from a working-class background and have been working non-stop since I was 14 years old. My first job was as an off-the-books dishwasher making below minimum wage. Now, I have the privilege of not only working in the field I studied, but with and for people who truly care for me and for each other.

Simply knowing that I would be given the time I needed to recover help[ed put my mind at ease and helped keep my head up even in the darkest moments of this odyssey. I thank you all and look forward to another year of laughter, tears, joy, and—hopefully—less hospital visits.

Gallery35, a collective of multi-disciplinary visual artists, continues its 2023-24 season with their November/December exhibit "Inspired By"

Our artists were invited to create new work that was inspired by other artists. The show offers an extraordinarily diverse collection of works, some influenced by famous artists (past and contemporary) as well as local art instructors. We were inspired by European artists including Rembrandt, Matisse, Modigliani, Manet, Bonheur, Ingres, Picasso and Bolot, to Japanese artists Tohaku and Kusama, Cuban artist Elso to photographer Haas, to mid-20th century O'Keeffe, Warhol, and Frankenthaler.

An Artists' Reception was held on Friday, November 19.
